Huston-Tillotson professor moves into Dumpster



Jeff Wilson, aka Professor Dumpster, moves into a 33-square-foot Dumpster on the Huston-Tillotson University campus in Austin on Tuesday, Feb. 4, 2014. He will live in the Dumpster for a year to show that people can live with less. Wilson, Huston-Tillotson's dean of the University College and associate professor of biological sciences, is also the leader of The Dumpster Project, a nonprofit focused on sustainability education. Wilson will sleep on campus in the Dumpster, which will eventually be transformed into a fully functioning home with running water, a toilet, a shower and solar-generated electricity. A "house-warming" party is planned for Friday at 4:30 p.m.
